Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs. 169000.00 which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid Submission (i.e.Paush 1, 2082).
